

Self-Assessment Rubric for EFL Lesson on "Myths about Happiness"

Instructions: For each category, circle the number of the statement you agree with the most.

1. Vocabulary Understanding and Usage

- **5:** I can accurately define and use all the key vocabulary terms and phrases in context.
- **4:** I can define most of the key vocabulary and phrases and use some in context.
- **3:** I understand some of the key vocabulary and phrases but struggle to use them in context.
- **2:** I recognize a few vocabulary words and phrases but cannot define them.
- **1:** I do not understand the key vocabulary terms and phrases.

2. Comprehension and Discussion Participation

- **5:** I actively participated in the group discussions and comprehended the video content fully.
- **4:** I participated in the discussions and understood most of the video content.
- **3:** I participated but had some difficulty understanding the video.
- **2:** I was mostly quiet during discussions and had difficulty understanding the video.
- **1:** I did not participate in discussions and did not understand the video.

3. Critical Thinking and Argumentation

- **5:** I critically assessed the myths and posed thoughtful arguments during discussions.
- **4:** I made some assessments and provided a couple of arguments.
- **3:** I tried to think critically but did not provide arguments.
- **2:** I listened but neither thought critically nor provided arguments.
- **1:** I was not engaged in critical thinking or argumentation.

4. Presentation and Peer Interaction

- **5:** I effectively presented my stance and supporting arguments, and actively listened to my peers, providing constructive feedback.
- **4:** I presented my stance and supporting arguments and listened to my peers.
- **3:** I presented but had difficulty listening to my peers.
- **2:** I listened to my peers but did not present my stance and supporting arguments.
- **1:** I neither presented my stance and supporting arguments nor listened to my peers.

5. Interest in the Topic of Happiness and Life Choices

- **5:** I am highly interested in the topic and want to explore it further.
- **4:** I am interested and may look into some aspects more.
- **3:** I have a moderate interest but am not sure if I'll explore it further.
- **2:** I have limited interest in the topic.
- **1:** I am not interested in the topic of happiness and life choices.
