Counter English

The everyday phrases for ordering, shopping and paying.

カフェやお店での自然な言い方。

LINES YOU SAY · 自分が言う表現

Could I get...?

～をお願いします

"Could I get a small latte, please?"

The natural counter opener. More natural than **I would like...**, more polite than **I want...**

Does this come in...?

これ、別のサイズ（色）はありますか

"Does this come in a medium?" · "Does this come in blue?"

Asking for another size, colour or variant in a shop.

Can I pay by card?

カードで払えますか

"Can I pay by card?"

Settling up at the end.

LINES YOU CATCH · 聞き取って答える表現（自分から言う必要はありません）

For here or to go?

店内でお召し上がりですか、お持ち帰りですか

You answer: **For here, please.** / **To go, please.**

Will that be all?

ご注文は以上でよろしいですか

You answer: **That's all, thanks.**

More clerk lines to catch

- Cash or card? → "Card, please."
- Anything else? → "No, that's everything."
- Would you like a bag? → "Yes, please." / "No, I'm fine."
- What size would you like? → "Small, please."

Small talk bank

- Clerk: "How's your day going?"
- Clerk: "Busy morning?"
- Clerk: "Nice weather today."
- You: "Pretty good, thanks — you?"
- You: "Just getting started, actually."
- You: "Just the one coffee today, thanks."

Open → ask for an option → answer the routine question → **close** → pay
